- Discrimination allegations may be reported to the Office for the Prevention of Harassment & Discrimination (OPHD) with supporting evidence/documentation.
- The UC San Diego Academic Senate Privilege and Tenure Committee considers grievances filed by Senate members regarding alleged violations of their rights and privileges, and allegations of faculty misconduct filed by the Administration. It advises the Administration and the Division on general policies involving privilege and tenure of Senate members. The Senate's Privilege and Tenure Panel of Advisors are available to Senate members who are considering filing a grievance or who have been notified by the Administration that they are the subject of a disciplinary hearing. Advisors provide peer counseling, but do not serve as representatives of faculty members.
